

The Municipality Council of the Umvoti Municipality, Acting under the authority of Sections 17 and 24 (2) (a) (ii) of the Municipal Finance Management Act, Act, 56 of 2003 read together with sections 21(3) and 75A of the Municipal System Act, act 32 of 2000 and section 14 of the Municipal Property Rates Act, Act 6 of 2004, as amended, hereby repeals all its tariff of charges and publishes the consolidated tariff of charges, as made by the Umvoti municipality Council at its meeting held on 13th June 2014 and Minutes under UMS 164(1) which tariff shall come into operation with effect from the 1 July 2014.
